Perfect North is located just west of Cincinnati, and just north of Lawrenceburg, IN.

Tom,

I am the newsletter editor for the Tri State Ski Club in Evansville Indiana. I would like to include the info presented here about the Perfect North passes in my next newsletter, also the PDF file you included.

Alternatively, (if you say no) I would like to include your email address in the newsletter. Last year Paoli Peaks had kind of a short season because of warm weather; I don't think Perfect North had those problems. I would like to have an alternative that's not too far away for our members. (I've never been to Perfect North)

Pete,

Yes, you can include the information in your newsletter and you can include my email. Hope some of your members may want an alternative to Paoli. Perfect North did have a better season than Paoli last year. We had to cancel races at Paoli when they were racing at Perfect. Perfect North has a unique setup that their slopes face directly North and since their lodge is at the bottom and they are in a valley with a slope on the other side of the valley about the same height as Perfect North's slopes, once they get snow in the valley, they basically form their own weather system. Once they get a snow base established, they usually have a 10 to 15 degree difference than what is in downtown Cincinnati so they can make snow more often. There are times that they can make snow at the bottom of the hill when it is too warm at the top of the hill because the cold stays in the valley.

Attached is the prices for the pass discounts. I know a couple other clubs have someone that handles these pass sales for their club. I just wanted to pass this info onto the clubs that don't have a rep for their club. Below is the instructions to purchase the pass online with the discount.

To purchase a pass online: Go to www.perfectnorth.com

To purchase a pass, click on the [Club Log-in](#) in the upper right corner. Then click on the letter "C" and then click on [Cincinnati Ski Club](#). Enter [catwalk](#) for the password.

Click [BUY](#) to purchase a pass.

Enter [Cinti Ski](#) for the group name.

Enter the password [catwalk](#).

Click on the pass you want and you can purchase additional passes and add-on options to passes all at the same time.

Click on [Guest Lookup](#) to find your information if you had a pass previously. If you have not purchased a pass at Perfect, then click on [Guest Lookup](#) and then [Create New Guest](#).

Perfect North Slopes Passes 2008-09

For CSC Members...

We have discount pass prices that are cheaper than you can purchase directly from Perfect North. These prices will be available through the Nov. 19 meeting or online until Nov 28. They can also be purchased online through www.perfectnorth.com, but you need the club's password to access the pass prices.

Contact Tom Berning via email or 513-231-6998 for the password. You must be a current member to purchase passes at these prices. These prices will only be available online until Nov 28. After Nov. 28, the prices go up but are still below the regular season prices from Perfect.

Gold Flex Card: This pass gives you an 8 hour lift ticket every day of the season. You must visit the ticket window each visit to get a lift ticket. Ages 13-59 \$300 and Ages 7-12/60+ \$240. Options are Flex Rentals \$125, 4 weeks of lessons \$40, Gold snow tubing pass \$60 or Gold Lite snow tubing pass \$30.

Gold Lite Flex Card: This pass gives you an 8 hour lift ticket every day from Sunday after 5:30pm through Thursday. This pass is not good on Friday, Saturday or before 5:30 on Sunday. Ages 13-59 \$259 and Ages 7-12/60+ \$207. Options are Flex rentals \$125, 4 weeks of lessons \$40, Gold snow tubing pass \$60 or Gold Lite snow tubing pass \$30.

Silver Flex Card: This pass gives you one 8 hour lift ticket per week. You can use this lift ticket any day of the week. A week is Monday - Sunday. Ages 13-59 \$210 and Ages 7-12/60+ \$168. Options are Flex Rentals \$100, 4 weeks of lessons \$40, Gold snow tubing pass \$60 or Gold Lite snow tubing pass \$30.

Bronze Flex Card: This pass gives you one 8 hour lift ticket per week. The lift ticket is good Monday through Thursday and after 5:30pm on Sundays. Ages 13-59 \$154 and Ages 7-12/60+ \$123. Options are Flex Rentals \$100, 4 weeks of lessons \$40, Gold snow tubing pass \$60 or Gold Lite tubing pass \$30.

4 Week Lesson Program: This pass is for 4 lift tickets and 4 lessons on the 4 Thursdays in January starting Jan 8. When you complete 2 lessons, you will get 1 extra lift ticket and when you complete the remaining 2 lessons you will get a second extra lift ticket (and rentals if you purchased rentals with the pass) that can be used any time. If you miss one of the Thursdays, you can schedule a makeup. You can take ski or snowboard lessons. The lessons are 60 minute lessons that are available at 1:00, 6:00, 7:00 and 8:00 for all levels. Options are Flex Rentals \$44.

There are two snow tubing only passes available. Gold Snow Tubing pass for \$120 gives you unlimited use of the snow tubing park. You must present pass for a tubing ticket. Gold Lite Snow Tubing pass \$60 gives you unlimited tubing on Mondays through Thursdays and after 5:30pm on Sundays. Flex Rentals gives you an option of either ski rentals or snowboard rentals. You can choose which you want at each visit.

Anyone purchasing a pass can also purchase a debit card. This card can be used towards lift tickets, tubing, food, in the loft shop or in the repair shop. If you purchase a \$35 card, you get \$40. If you purchase a \$50 card you get \$60 and if you purchase a \$80 card you get \$100. The bonus offers are only available at the time you purchase your pass. Bonus money is not available until opening day.
